

GLOBAL GROUND SUPPORT, LLC FAR/DFARS FLOWDOWN PROVISIONS FOR FIXED PRICE PURCHASE ORDER/SUBCONTRACT FOR COMMERCIAL ITEMS UNDER A UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT CONTRACT

Effective for orders placed after: March 1, 2024

This order incorporates one or more Federal Acquisition Regulations (FAR) and Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement (DFARS) provisions/clauses by reference with the same force and effect as if they were given in full text. For FAR and DFARS provisions incorporated by reference, "Government" means "Global Ground Support, LLC", "Contractor" means "Seller," "Contracting Officer" means "Global Ground Support Purchasing Representative," and "Subcontractor" means "Seller's Subcontractor" (unless expressly set forth otherwise below). The words "Government" and "Contracting Officer" do not change: (1) when a right, act, authorization or obligation can be granted or performed only by the Government or the prime contract Contracting Officer or duly authorized representative, such as in DFARS 252.227-7015; (2) when the Government shall have the unrestricted right to use, modify, reproduce, release, perform, display or disclose technical data. Nothing in this order grants Seller a direct right of action against the Government. Such provisions/clauses are identified below and elsewhere in this order by their title, effectivity date, and reference where they appear in the FAR and/or DFARS.
